INIS

The International Nuclear Information System (INIS) is one of the world's largest custodians of published information on the peaceful uses of nuclear science and technology. It was established in 1970 in response to the IAEA's mandate to "foster the exchange of scientific and technical information on peaceful uses of atomic energy".

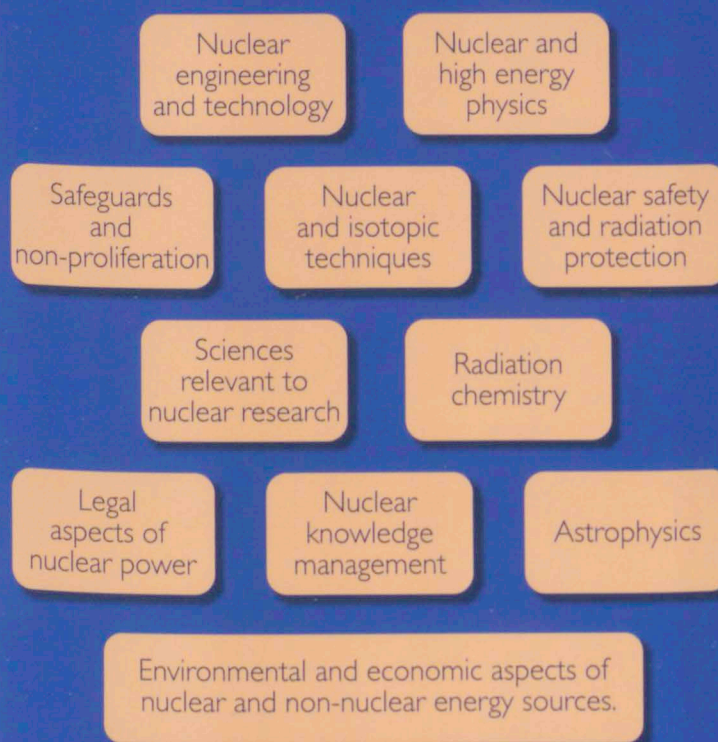
International Cooperation

INIS is operated by the IAEA in collaboration with 128 Member States and 24 international organizations. This government level international cooperation is one of the hallmarks of INIS.

INIS Database and Non-Conventional Literature (NCL)

- Leading reference database for scientific literature published worldwide on the peaceful uses of nuclear science and technology
- Comprehensive international coverage by INIS Members and the INIS Secretariat
- Over 3.6 million bibliographic citations and abstracts of journal articles, scientific and technical reports, conference papers, proceedings, books, patents, theses, laws, regulations and standards, and web documents, covering publications in 63 languages; all records include keywords and most have an abstract in English
- Includes a unique online collection of over 340 000 full-text documents: scientific and technical reports, conference proceedings, patents, theses, and preprints. This "grey" non-conventional literature (NCL) is not easily available from other sources or non-commercially published.
- Average annual increase of over 100 000 records

INIS Multilingual Thesaurus

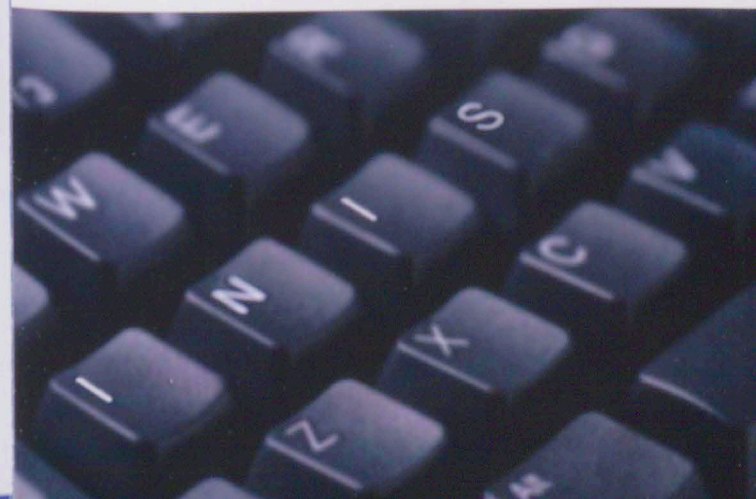
