MP: Closing down Lynas not part of PH manifesto

KUALA TERENGGANU: The closure of rare earth processing plant Lynas Malaysia Sdn Bhd in Gebeng, Pahang, is not part of the Pakatan Harapan manifesto as some are claiming, says the Entrepreneur Development Minister.

Datuk Seri Mohd Redzuan Yusof (*pic*) said as there was no such pledge, all Pakatan MPs must respect the government's decision to continue with the project.

"Pakatan never promised to shut down Lynas in its GE14 manifesto, everybody can check that. I call on my colleagues in Pakatan to stop raising the issue and causing anxiety among the people in the area as experts have verified the plant is safe," he told reporters after attending an entrepreneur gathering here yesterday.



On another matter, Redzuan said it was time for the aerospace regulations in the country to be reviewed.

"Malaysia needs to provide a conducive environment in order for the industry to grow and this includes relaxing the regulations, particularly in-flight testing," he said.

He said compared with other countries such as Australia, Malaysia was far behind in the aerospace industry.

On reports about a possible Cabinet reshuffle in the near future, the Alor Gajah MP said he would not have any problem if he was dropped from the line-up.

"I'm doing my job as entrusted to me, serving the people since July 2 last year.

"It is up to the Prime Minister (to decide)," he said. — Bernama
